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- Franklin specific covid mitigation measures, whatever MPS is requiring as well as whatever our leadership has determined to be in the best interest for our school.
 - We follow the mitigation measures from the district. The district follows the County measures. The district has started up the COVID Dashboard again. It lists both total cases and active cases. Currently we no active cases as of 9/7/2021. Mitigation that you will see at our school:
 - Controlled dismissal, students for parent pick up stay in classroom until called.
 - Frequent hand washing and sanitizing stations
 - Masks are required to ride the bus
 - 50% capacity indoors/ 75% capacity outdoors
 - Virtual Flag raising, since we wouldn't be able to have all the students in the courtvard
 - Adjusting performances, such as Winter Sing, Band and Orchestra concerts
 - Currently all fieldtrips are cancelled
