- Adding a 2nd Fundraiser Mrs. deJesus has been talking with the Principals Council about amending the by laws to allow each school to have 2 fundraisers a year.
 - Would we like to have a golf night as our 2nd fundraiser? We would rent the course at Golfland for \$200.00 for 3 hours. Course rental is available Monday through Thursday evenings from September to April. Golfland will set up a check in table for our FPO to collect money and to pass out the golf clubs and golf balls. The amount charged per person will be up to us.
